



Career support Year 9 students have had to date

- As part of their PHSE lessons all students have had an introduction to 'working life'
- Fortnightly career lessons that include using Unifrog, inform students on opportunities that are available to them
- Weekly 'career of the week' is shared, a short 2/3 mins video. Different career focus every week!
- In lessons, subject teachers signpost students by linking units of work / study with possible careers or pathways for the future



Career & Option support over the next few months

- Subject leaders deliver in person, subject assemblies to the year group. All option subjects are covered. This information will then be re-messaged during form time with form tutor.
- First week of February Yr9 reports will be circulated, these can be used to discuss options with subject teachers at parents evening on Thursday 6 February
- From the 2nd week in February each student will have a 1 to 1 interview with either a member of Leadership or SEND team


