PSHE Curriculum

I am writing to update you on the topics Year 9 will be studying in PSHE in the coming weeks. This half term, Year 9 will be focusing on 'Living in the Wider World' and will be learning about **employability skills**. Students will be taught:

- The options available for the future – different career pathways including apprenticeships, flexible/blended degrees, working, and studying/travelling abroad
- How their online presence can have an impact on their careers, and explore how to create an online presence that can boost their career prospects
- A range of employability skills – problem-solving, leadership, group work, interview-specific communication skills
- How to act on constructive feedback
- The habits and strategies that will support them with their progress as they move towards GCSEs
- The skills needed for particular sectors of the job market, and what skills they may need to develop for the areas of employment they are considering for their futures, of for further/higher education courses

PSHE involves both written work and group-based discussion work, and we really hope your child will enjoy exploring the range of topics that PSHE offers. Resources that we use are sourced from the PSHE Association and therefore approved by the Department for Education.
