### **Year 11 Theatre Trip: Macbeth, 12 February 2020**

As you will be aware, year 11 students will be revising Macbeth by William Shakespeare this half term; this text will feature on Literature paper 1 and thus constitutes an important part of your child's final Literature GCSE grade. The English Department have been lucky enough to secure some tickets to see a production of this text at the Yeadon Town hall in February; attendance is highly recommended as it will greatly aid students' revision of this challenging play.

The trip will take place for all year 11 classes on 12 February 2020 during school time and tickets will be issued on a 'first come first served' basis. Students will travel by coach, leaving school at approximately 10:15am and returning to school in time for lunch. The school requests a voluntary student/parent/carer contribution of £15.00. This contribution includes the ticket and travel costs. Students at school will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution is made in response to this request. However, whilst the contribution requested is voluntary and does not represent a charge, should insufficient contributions be received the school may have to cancel the proposed trip.
