Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to remind you that the Year 12 Parents' Consultation Evening is on Wednesday 4 December from 5.00pm to 7.30pm, in the school hall. You and your child are invited to attend. It is a valuable opportunity not only to obtain detailed progress information, but also to help fully prepare and support your child for their forthcoming mock examinations.
